1999 LEGISLATIVE REPORT CARD

Introduction

This report card is based on Senate and Assembly Floor votes on 20 important bills supported by California NOW. These 20 bills were selected because they represent a wide range of issues and each came to a floor vote in at least one house of the legislature.

Legislators were allotted 10 points for a “Yes” floor vote and 5 points for authoring a bill. 0 points were given for a “No” vote or for not voting. A percentage was then calculated for each member.

The following is a description of each bill used in this report card:

AB 26 (Migden)--Civil Rights; Domestic Partner Registration

Provides for the registration of domestic partners (who are same-sex couples or opposite-sex couples over the age of 62) with the Secretary of State.

AB 39 (Hertzberg) and SB 41 (Speier) (Women’s Contraceptive Equity Act)--Health Care; Contraceptive Insurance Coverage

Requires health care plans and disability insurance plans to provide coverage for prescription contraceptives.

AB 109 (Knox)--Employment; Sick Leave

Requires employers to permit employees to use accrued sick leave to attend to an illness of the employee’s child, parent or spouse.

AB 196 (Kuehl) and SB 542 (Burton)--Family Law; Child Support

Recast the state plan for child support enforcement.

AB 525 (Kuehl)—Health Care; Religious Health Care Providers

Sets forth requirements for mergers of religious-based hospitals with existing hospitals.

AB 537 (Kuehl)--Civil Rights; Discrimination in Public Schools

Makes it unlawful to harass or discriminate against lesbian, gay or bisexual students in public schools.

AB 558 (Jackson)--Domestic Violence; Public School Instruction

Requires that information about domestic violence programs and sample curricula for domestic violence prevention instruction be provided to school districts.

AB 633 (Steinberg)--Employment; Sweatshops
Strengthens protections for workers in the garment manufacturing industry.

AB 808 (Strom-Martin)—Family Law; Spousal Support
Requires the court when considering the age and health of the parties in determining a spousal support award to include in that consideration emotional distress resulting from domestic violence.

AB 908 (Alquist)—Education; Gender Equity
Requires gender equity training in teacher credential programs.

AB 1001 (Villaraigosa)—Civil Rights; Sexual Orientation Discrimination
Amends the Fair Employment and Housing Act (FEHA) to include sexual orientation within the prohibited bases for discrimination in employment and housing accommodations.

AB 1039 (Aroner): Economic Equity; Welfare Reform
Allows study time outside the classroom to be counted toward hourly work requirements for CalWORKs students and allows counties to provide subsidized employment for CalWORKs recipients as an alternative to community service.

SB 44 (Polanco): Civil Rights; Affirmative Action
Clarifies that the Proposition 209 language in the California Constitution does not prohibit public sector outreach and recruitment programs aimed at women and minorities.

SB 75 (Murray): Civil Rights; Domestic Partner Registration
Provides for the registration of domestic partners (same-sex and opposite-sex) with the Secretary of State.

SB 218 (Solis): Domestic Violence
Makes several changes strengthening domestic violence laws, including prohibiting a person subject to a restraining order from possessing a firearm.

SB 792 (Ortiz): Family Law; Child Custody
Provides that no parent shall be placed on supervised visitation or be denied child custody or visitation solely because the parent lawfully reported suspected sexual abuse of the child or took other specified reasonable actions with respect to suspected sexual abuse of the child.

SB 845 (Escutia)—Economic Equity; Child Care
Requires the establishment of a child care master plan for California.

SB 1154 (Speier)—Health Care; Breast and Gynecological Cancer
Establishes the Breast and Gynecological Cancer Treatment Program for uninsured and underinsured women.
