2001 LEGISLATIVE REPORT CARD

Introduction

This report card is based on Senate and Assembly floor votes on 24 important bills supported by California NOW. These 24 bills were selected because they represent a wide range of issues and each came to a floor vote (a vote by all members) in both houses of the State Legislature.

Legislators were allotted ten points for a “yes” vote and five points for authoring a bill. Zero points were given for a “no” vote or for an abstention (not voting or absent). A percentage was then calculated for each member. “Y” indicates a “yes” vote, “N” indicates a “no” vote, “NV” indicates the legislator did not vote, “A” indicates an excused absence, and “V” indicates a vacancy in the legislative seat.

This report card is based on voting records for selected bills only and does not take into account all the work performed or accomplishments achieved by each of the legislators. It is therefore not a definitive evaluation and does not constitute an endorsement or denunciation of any member of the State Legislature.

The following is a description of each bill used in this report card:

AB 25 (Migden) – *Domestic partners*

Provides registered domestic partners with several basic legal rights currently enjoyed by married couples, including the ability to make medical decisions for an incapacitated partner, act as a conservator, inherit property without a will, use the stepparent adoption procedure, use sick leave to care for a domestic partner, and file a wrongful death claim. (signed into law)

AB 43 (Wesson) – *Pay equity; state workers*

Directs the Commission on the Status of Women to evaluate state employee compensation and classification plans based on comparability and value of worth, with a focus on inequities between female-dominated and male-dominated jobs. (signed into law)

AB 144 (Cedillo) – *Public social services eligibility; vehicles*

Reforms the automobile resource rule for CalWORKs recipients by exempting \$15,000 in fair market value for one vehicle, and exempting the full value of a vehicle when the recipient is a victim of domestic violence. (vetoed)

AB 540 (Firebaugh) – *Public postsecondary education; residency*

Qualifies specified long-term California residents, regardless of citizenship status, for “resident” fee payments at California Community Colleges and the California State University. (signed into law)

AB 583 (Jackson) – *Dissolution of marriage; community property*

Requires each party to a dissolution of marriage to update his or her disclosure of all assets and liabilities fairly, fully, accurately, and immediately upon material change, imposes mandatory sanctions for violating asset disclosure requirements, and requires a court to set aside a judgment of dissolution where the disclosure laws have been violated. (signed into law)

AB 731 (Wayne) – *Domestic violence; protection orders*

Enacts the Uniform Interstate Enforcement of Domestic Violence Protection Orders Act which authorizes the enforcement of a valid protective order obtained in another state. (signed into law)

AB 767 (Goldberg) – *Public assistance; drug-related crimes*

Provides exemption from lifetime disqualification for food stamps, general assistance and CalWORKs for persons convicted of drug-related felonies if they meet specified criteria, including completion of a drug treatment program. (vetoed)

AB 819 (Jackson) – *Domestic violence prevention; public schools*

States the intent of the Legislature that public schools receiving funds pursuant to the School Safety and Violence Prevention Act provide age-appropriate instruction in domestic violence. (signed into law)

AB 1084 (Wesson) – *Public contracts*

Authorizes local government entities to provide for a small business preference in public contracts, and requires awarding departments to report on the level of participation of business enterprises by race, ethnicity and gender of owners. (signed into law)

AB 1088 (Jackson) – *Gender discrimination; pricing*

Requires certain businesses, including dry cleaners and hair salons, to disclose in writing the price charged for each service and to display the price list. (signed into law)

AB 1129 (Liu) – *Domestic violence restraining orders; dependency court*

Authorizes juvenile dependency courts to issue restraining orders against any person to protect the child who is the subject of the proceedings, or the child's parent, guardian or caretaker regardless of whether the child resides with that person. (NOW-sponsored) (signed into law)

AB 1426 (Wright) – *Child support; electronic transfer*

Allows payment of child support by electronic transfer from the employer's bank account when the employer has previously failed to comply with the child support assignment order. (signed into law)

AB 1475 (Liu) – *Employment harassment; religious exemption*

Extends the Fair Employment and Housing Act's prohibition against harassment to religious corporations with respect to their operation of non-religious health care facilities. (signed into law)

ACR 31 (Strom-Martin) – *Women's history resolution*

Proclaims March 2001 as Women's History Month and urges that an accurate and inclusive women's history curriculum be included in public school educational materials and instruction for pupils in grades 1 to 12. (NOW-sponsored) (signed into law)

SB 66 (Kuehl) – *Domestic violence protective orders; background checks*

Requires the court to search specified records, prior to the issuance or denial of a protective order, to determine if the proposed subject of the order has any specified prior criminal convictions or outstanding warrants, is on parole or probation, or is or was the subject of other protective or restraining orders. (signed into law)

SB 78 (Kuehl) – *Premarital agreements; spousal support*

Provides that a premarital agreement regarding a waiver of spousal support is not enforceable unless independent counsel represented the party against whom enforcement is sought at the time the agreement was signed. (signed into law)

SB 225 (Kuehl) – *Education; discrimination in interscholastic athletics*

Strengthens and clarifies the remedies available to student athletes in incidents involving discrimination. (signed into law)

SB 380 (Murray) – *CalWORKs; study time for students*

Allows one hour of study time for each hour of class (up to six hours maximum) to count toward the 32-hour work requirement for CalWORKs participants who are students in an educational program that leads to employment. (vetoed)

SB 700 (Karnette) – *Female inmates; family visitation*

Allows a female prisoner who does not have a release date set to have overnight visits with her children under the age of 21. (vetoed)

SB 780 (Ortiz) – *Freedom of Access to Clinic Entrances Act (FACE)*

Provides protections against anti-abortion violence by making certain activities that interfere with access to reproductive health facilities a crime. (signed into law)

SB 1080 (Bowen) – *Health care; gynecological cancers*

Requires physicians to provide patients with an understandable standardized summary explaining symptoms and methods for diagnosing gynecological cancers during annual examinations, and makes physicians subject to citation or fine when they fail to comply. (signed into law)

SB 1169 (Alpert) – *Pharmacists; emergency contraception*

Authorizes a pharmacist to initiate emergency contraception drug therapy in accordance with standardized protocols developed by the pharmacist and an authorized prescriber. (signed into law)

SB 1197 (Romero) – *Sick leave; care for child, parent or spouse*

Provides that if an employer maintains an absence control policy that counts sick leave used to attend to an illness of a child, parent, or spouse as a basis for discipline, discharge, demotion, or suspension, the policy constitutes a per se violation of the law. (vetoed)

SB 1221 (Romero) – *Spousal support; domestic violence*

Creates a rebuttable presumption that any award of spousal support to an abusive spouse should not be made where there is a criminal conviction for an act of domestic violence perpetrated by the abusive spouse against the other spouse entered by the court within five years prior to the filing of the dissolution proceeding, or at any time thereafter. (signed into law)
