

# CALIFORNIA NATIONAL ORGANIZATION FOR WOMEN

## 2002 LEGISLATIVE REPORT CARD

### Introduction

This report card is based on Senate and Assembly floor votes on 20 significant bills affecting issues important to California NOW. These 20 bills were selected because they represent a wide range of issues and each came to a floor vote in both houses of the State Legislature.

The percentage scores are based on the proportion of votes favorable to CANOW's positions on the bills. Legislators received credit for a "yes" vote (Y) on bills supported by CANOW and for a "no" vote (N) on bills opposed by CANOW. No credit was given for not voting (NV) or for an excused absence (A).

This report card is based on voting records for selected bills only and does not take into account all the work performed or accomplishments achieved by each of the legislators. It is therefore not a definitive evaluation and does not constitute an endorsement or denunciation of any member of the State Legislature.

*The following is a description of each bill used in this report card. An "S" indicates that the bill was signed into law by the Governor. A "V" indicates that the bill was vetoed by the Governor. The position given ("support" or "oppose") is CANOW's position on the bill.*

**AB 1309** (Goldberg): *Employer Reports on Gender and Ethnicity* (V)

Requires specified employers to file reports breaking down the composition of their workforce by gender and ethnicity and makes the reports open to public inspection. (support)

**AB 1860** (Migden): *Sexual Assault Victims; Emergency Contraception* (S)

Requires medical professionals treating female sexual assault victims to provide counseling about the risk of pregnancy and dispense emergency contraception upon request. (support)

**AB 1928** (Jackson): *Civil Action for Gender-Motivated Violence* (sponsored by NOW) (S)

Permits a person injured by a crime of violence motivated by gender to bring a civil action for damages against the attacker. This bill was modeled after the civil remedies provision of the federal Violence Against Women Act (VAWA). (support)

**AB 1947** (Washington): *Food Stamp Eligibility; Drug-Related Felony* (V)

Creates an exemption from the lifetime ban on receipt of Food Stamps for persons convicted of drug-related felonies if they are enrolled in or have completed a drug treatment program in accordance with Proposition 36 (Substance Abuse and Crime Prevention Act of 2000). (support)

**AB 2194** (Jackson): *Medical Residency Abortion Training* (S)

Requires medical residency programs in obstetrics and gynecology to include access to training in the performance of abortion services. (support)

**AB 2216** (Keeley): *Domestic Partners; Intestate Succession* (S)

Permits a domestic partner to inherit his or her deceased partner's separate property that is not disposed of through a will in the same manner as the surviving spouse of an intestate (without a will) decedent. (support)

**AB 2240** (Wright): *Setting Aside Paternity Judgments* (V)

Allows a default judgment establishing paternity to be set aside if the party challenging the paternity judgment brings a motion to set aside within three years of discovering the possibility that the previously established father is not the biological father. (oppose)

**AB 2295** (Oropeza): *Athletic Equity; Title IX Compliance* (S)

Requires an independent evaluator to review interscholastic athletic programs and their rate of compliance with Title IX. (support)

**AB 2386** (Keeley): *CalWORKs Time Limit; Disability Extension* (V)

Extends the welfare-to-work time limit for up to 12 months when needed because the participant has a diagnosed physical, mental or learning disability. (support)

**AB 2652** (Chu): *Domestic Violence Courts* (V)

Establishes a task force to study and assess existing domestic violence court systems and create a set of model guidelines for establishing and operating domestic violence courts in California. (support)

**SB 253** (Ortiz): *Stem Cell Research* (S)

Allows research involving the derivation and use of human embryonic stem cells, human embryonic germ cells, and human adult stem cells from any source, including somatic cell nuclear transplantation. (support)

**SB 390** (Escutia): *Child Care Master Plan* (V)

Requires the State Department of Education to develop a state master plan for child care and development in consultation and collaboration with an oversight task force established by the bill. (support)

**SB 1301** (Kuehl): *Reproductive Privacy Act* (co-sponsored by NOW) (S)

Enacts the "Reproductive Privacy Act" which ensures California women's access to safe and legal abortion even if federal protections are weakened. (support)

**SB 1362** (Karnette): *Female Inmates; Visitation with Children* (V)

Allows a female prisoner who does not have a release date set to have overnight visits with her children under the age of 21. (support)

**SB 1411** (Speier): *Maternity Parity Act; Health Insurance Fees for Maternity Services* (S)

Prohibits health insurance carriers from charging higher copayments or deductibles for maternity services than for other covered medical services. (support)

**SB 1421** (Romero): *Sexual Battery; Purported Professional Purpose* (sponsored by NOW) (S)

Protects women from sexual assault by medical personnel (or other professionals) who fraudulently induce the victim to consent to physical contact by claiming that the contact serves a professional purpose. This bill makes such conduct a crime. (support)

**SB 1471** (Romero): *Employee Sick Leave; Care for Family Member* (S)

Prohibits an employer from maintaining an absence control policy that counts the use of sick leave to care for a family member as a basis for discipline, discharge etc. (support)

**SB 1538** (Burton): *Mandatory Arbitration; FEHA* (V)

Prohibits pre-dispute mandatory arbitration agreements with respect to employment discrimination claims brought pursuant to the Fair Employment and Housing Act (FEHA). (support)

**SB 1658** (Soto): *Child Support Enforcement; Defense of Laches* (S)

Permits the defense of laches (a claim that the plaintiff waited too long to enforce the judgment) to be used in an action to enforce a judgment for child or spousal support only with respect to any portion of the judgment owed to the state. (support)

**SB 1661** (Kuehl): *Paid Family Leave* (S)

Provides partially paid disability leave for an employee who must take time off work to care for a seriously ill family member or new child. (support)
