2003 LEGISLATIVE REPORT CARD

Introduction

This report card is based on Senate and Assembly floor votes on 20 significant bills supported by California NOW. These 20 bills were selected because they represent a wide range of issues and each came to a floor vote (a vote by all members) in both houses of the State Legislature.

Legislators received credit for a “yes” vote (Y) on the bills. No credit was given for voting “no” (N), not voting (NV) or for an excused absence (A). A percentage was then calculated for each member.

This report card is based on voting records for selected bills only and does not take into account all the work performed or accomplishments achieved by each of the legislators. It is therefore not a definitive evaluation and does not constitute an endorsement or denunciation of any member of the State Legislature.

The following is a description of each bill used in this report card. An “S” indicates that the bill was signed into law by the Governor. A “V” indicates that the bill was vetoed by the Governor.

AB 17 (Kehoe): Domestic Partners; State Contracts (S)

Prohibits state agencies from contracting with companies that discriminate between domestic partners of employees and spouses of employees with respect to the provision of benefits.

AB 51 (Simitian): Child Care; Land Use (V)

Requires city and county land use plans to identify categories of land use for child care facilities.

AB 54 (Oropeza): Cultural Competency Training for Educators (S)

Requires a study of the availability and effectiveness of cultural competency training for school teachers and administrators, resulting in a report that includes recommendations to the Legislature based on the results of the study.

AB 76 (Corbett): Sexual Harassment by Non-Employees (co-sponsored by CANOW) (S)

Protects employees from sexual harassment by clients or customers by requiring employers to take reasonable steps to prevent further harassment of an employee by a non-employee once the employer knows or should have known of the harassing conduct.

AB 134 (Cohn): Domestic Violence; Criminal Penalties (S)

Adds domestic battery to the list of offenses which subjects the defendant to increased punishment upon a second or subsequent conviction.

AB 196 (Leno): Employment and Housing Discrimination; Gender Identity (S)

Prohibits discrimination in housing and employment based on gender identity and expression.

AB 205 (Goldberg): Domestic Partners; Rights and Responsibilities (S)

Enacts the California Domestic Partner Rights and Responsibilities Act of 2003 which provides registered domestic partners with most of the rights, benefits, responsibilities and obligations currently applied to married couples.

AB 231 (Steinberg): Food Stamps; Eligibility (S)

Reduces barriers to participation in the food stamp program by exempting one car per family in determining eligibility for food stamps.

AB 458 (Chu): Foster Care; Discrimination (S)

Protects foster children from discrimination and harassment on the basis of race, ethnic group identification, ancestry, national origin, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, disability or HIV status.

AB 833 (Steinberg): Women's Athletics in Schools (S)

Codifies the federal three-prong test currently used to determine whether a school's athletic program is in compliance with Title IX to ensure that its application in California reflects current federal law even if federal interpretation of the test is weakened.

AB 898 (Chu): Sexual Assault; Victim's DNA Bill of Rights (S)

Establishes the "Sexual Assault Victims' DNA Bill of Rights" requiring police to inform sexual assault victims about the status of DNA evidence, including testing and disposal of the evidence.

AB 996 (Wiggins): Reproductive Health Services Facility; Insurance (S)

Prohibits insurance companies from canceling, refusing to renew or unreasonably increasing premiums of a policy issued to a reproductive health services facility on the basis that a claim has been made as a result of a hate crime or anti-reproductive-rights crime committed against the facility.

AB 1715 (Committee on Judiciary): Employment Discrimination; Arbitration Agreements (V)

Prohibits employers from requiring employees to sign pre-dispute mandatory arbitration agreements with respect to employment discrimination claims brought pursuant to the Fair Employment and Housing Act (FEHA).

SB 2 (Burton and Speier): Employer-Based Health Care (S)

Requires specified employers to provide health care coverage to their employees.

SB 71 (Kuehl): Sex Education in Schools (S)

Consolidates and clarifies existing law regarding sex education and HIV/AIDS education curriculum and ensures that sex education in public schools is comprehensive, medically accurate and free of bias.

SB 265 (Kuehl): Child Custody; Domestic Violence (S)

Strengthens protections against court awards of child custody to perpetrators of domestic violence.

SB 490 (Alpert): Emergency Contraception; Pharmacists (S)

Authorizes a pharmacist to dispense emergency contraception in accordance with a standardized procedure approved by the Board of Pharmacy and the Medical Board of California.

SB 545 (Speier): Emergency Contraception; Pharmacists (S)

Eliminates the special training requirement for pharmacists dispensing emergency contraception (EC) and prohibits a pharmacist from charging a separate consultation fee for EC.

SB 784 (Karnette): Domestic Violence; Criminal Defense of Battering and Its Effects (S)

Extends the time for victims of domestic violence who were convicted of homicide to file a writ of habeas corpus on the basis of evidence related to “Battered Women's Syndrome” that was not introduced at trial.

SB 932 (Bowen): Reproductive Health Services; Sale of Health Care Facility (S)

Prohibits the seller of a health care facility from restricting the type of medical services that may be provided by the purchaser of the facility if the restriction impedes a patient’s access to medical care.
