2004 LEGISLATIVE REPORT CARD

Introduction

This report card is based on Senate and Assembly floor votes on 18 significant bills supported by California NOW. These 18 bills were selected because they represent a wide range of issues and each came to a floor vote (a vote by all members) in both houses of the State Legislature.

Legislators received credit for a “yes” vote (Y) on the bills. No credit was given for voting “no” (N), not voting (NV) or for an excused absence (A). A percentage was then calculated for each member.

This report card is based on voting records for selected bills only and does not take into account all the work performed or accomplishments achieved by each of the legislators. It is therefore not a definitive evaluation and does not constitute an endorsement or denunciation of any member of the State Legislature.

The following is a description of each bill used in this report card. An “S” indicates that the bill was signed into law by the Governor. A “V” indicates that the bill was vetoed by the Governor.

AB 358 (Jackson) – CEDAW (V)

Protects against gender-based discrimination by requiring the state to implement the principles of the Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination Against Women (CEDAW).

AB 1825 (Reyes) -- Sexual Harassment; Training and Education (S)

Requires employers with 50 or more employees to provide sexual harassment education and training to all supervisory employees.

AB 2208 (Kehoe) -- Domestic Partners; Insurance Benefits (S)

Requires insurers to treat registered domestic partners equal to spouses when providing insurance coverage.

AB 2317 (Oropeza) – Gender Pay Equity (V)

Imposes increased financial penalties on employers who discriminate based on gender in paying their employees.

AB 2404 (Steinberg) -- Gender Equity in Community Athletics (S)

Applies Title IX factors in determining whether cities or counties are discriminating based on gender in community youth athletic programs.

AB 2900 (Laird) -- Employment Discrimination (S)

Makes all employment non-discrimination provisions in California law consistent with the expansive non-discrimination provisions in the Fair Employment and Housing Act which prohibits discrimination based on race, religion, color, national origin, ancestry, disability, marital status, sex, age or sexual orientation.

AB 2387 (Firebaugh) -- Public Postsecondary Education; Admissions Policies (V)

Authorizes the University of California and the California State University to consider culture, race, gender, ethnicity, national origin, geographic origin and household income in college admissions to achieve the goal of a diverse student body.

AB 2832 (Lieber) – Minimum Wage (V)

Increases the minimum wage to \$7.25 per hour as of July 1, 2005, and to \$7.75 per hour as of July 1, 2006.

AJR 57 (Jackson) -- Reproductive rights; Roe v. Wade (S)

Requests the Congress and the President of the United States to protect and uphold the intent and substance of the United States Supreme Court decision in Roe v. Wade, relating to reproductive rights.

AJR 85 (Leno) – Same-Sex Couples (S)

Declares the California Legislature's opposition to any federal enactment designed to prohibit or restrict the provision of rights and obligations under the law for same-sex couples and their families.

SB 1178 (Kuehl) – Foster Care; Teen Parents (S)

Enacts the Teen Parents in Foster Care Act and requires the foster care system to protect the best interests of minor parents and their children as a unit.

SB 1287 (Kuehl) – Prisoners; Incarcerated Parents (V)

Enacts the Families and Children of the Incarcerated Act and requires the court to advise a criminal defendant of the consequences of a conviction on the defendant's parental rights before the defendant accepts a plea.

SB 1343 (Escutia) -- Child Care Master Plan (V)

Requires development of recommendations for a state master plan for high-quality, affordable infant and toddler care accessible to all California families.

SB 1385 (Burton) -- Battering and its Effects; Habeas Relief for Prisoners (S)

Allows more convicted prisoners to petition for post-conviction relief on the basis that evidence of "intimate partner battering and its effects" was not allowed at their trial.

SB 1441 (Kuehl) -- Domestic Violence; Counselor and Support Person (S)

Gives victims of domestic violence the right to have a counselor and a support person present at any interview by law enforcement, district attorneys or defense attorneys.

SB 1525 (Speier) -- Health Care; Family Planning and Cancer Detection Services (V)

Requires the Department of Health Services to consolidate the Family Planning, Access, Care, and Treatment (Family PACT) and Every Woman Counts (EWC) programs to be administered by the Office of Family Planning in order to expand family planning and cancer detection services to uninsured, low-income women.

SB 1555 (Speier) -- Maternity Services; Health Care Coverage (V)

Requires all health insurers to provide coverage for maternity services.

SB 1760 (Perata) – Waiver of Sovereign Immunity; Americans with Disabilities Act (V)

Waives the state's sovereign immunity defense for Americans with Disabilities Act violations.
